	UNCENSORED - Lots of rear ends!

	- Highlight "Lullaby Land" on Page 2 of Fables and Fairy Tales submenu - Move Left... A highlighted sword will appear - Press ENTER - Walt discusses the background of Charles Kingsley and <i>Water Babies</i> ; Disney voice favorite Paul Frees can be heard as the animated version of Kingsley - The Silly Symphony will play after this feature has concluded

	SUMMARY - Scandal erupts when Cock Robin is mysteriously shot by an arrow while he romances the sultry Jenny Wren.
