Hawaiian Holiday	DATE - September 24, 1937
	DIRECTOR - Ben Sharpsteen
	SUMMARY - The gang takes a vacation to Hawaii. Goofy has some surfing problems, Donald learns why you don't wear a grass skirt near a fire, Mickey plays the ukulele, and Minnie dances.
	BEHIND THE SHORTS - Hawaii didn't become a state until August 21, 1959, some 22 years after this short was presented. Goofy would return to Hawaii in the 1952 short <i>Hello, Aloha</i> .
Moose Hunters	DATE - February 20, 1937
	DIRECTOR - Ben Sharpsteen
	SUMMARY - Donald and Goofy try to lure a moose by dressing up as a female of the species.
	BEHIND THE SHORTS - Mostly Donald and Goofy's film; Mickey spends most of the short literally up a tree.
The Worm Turns	DATE - January 2, 1937
	DIRECTOR - Ben Sharpsteen
	SUMMARY - Mickey shows mad scientist tendencies when he concocts a super-strength potion that turns the meek against their oppressors.
	BEHIND THE SHORTS - Excessively violent for a Disney short, Mickey's "secret lab" was later recalled in the Queen's dungeon in <i>Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs</i> (1937).
Magician Mickey	UNCENSORED - Pete sticks his gun against Pluto, saying "I'm gonna blow your head off."
	DATE - February 6, 1937
	DIRECTOR - Dave Hand
	SUMMARY - Mickey has to deal with a heckling Donald during his magic act.
Mickey's Amateurs	BEHIND THE SHORTS - Donald is especially hostile toward Mickey in this one...
	UNCENSORED - ...eventually pulling a pistol on him and stagehand Goofy. Also, Goofy conducts current when he sticks his finger in a live light socket.
	DATE - April 17, 1937
	DIRECTOR - Pinto Colvig, Walt Pfeiffer, and Ed Penner
	SUMMARY - Mickey hosts an amateur hour featuring Donald's attempts to recite "Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star," a performance by Clara Cluck with Clarabelle Cow accompanying on piano, and Goofy's one-man band.
	BEHIND THE SHORTS - Hoping for inspiration, Walt turned to storymen Colvig, Pfeiffer, and Penner to direct this short. Colvig is best known as the voice of Goofy. Pfeiffer was Walt's childhood friend; they used to perform together as "The Two Walts."
	UNCENSORED - Donald pulls a machine gun on the audience ... yes, a machine gun.
